Question 1 Bridge Articles

Vote for either Question 1A or 1B below by placing a  in the box. The  denotes which choice you prefer.

1A. Do you support the State of Maine Department of Transportation replacing the swing bridge in Naples with another swing bridge with any cost exceeding \$11 million coming from the Town of Naples, and/or other Lake Region Communities, and/or the local businesses, and/or the Army Corp of Engineers.

1B. Do you support the alternative plan proposed by MDOT to remove the swing bridge in Naples and replace it with a fixed (non-opening) bridge which will have a total cost of \$8 million for a decorative bridge and enlarging the Causeway and stabilizing the seawall and to include decorative lighting, fencing etc, with all costs borne by the State of Maine, with a project footprint extending from the Bay of Naples Cabins to Sandy's Flightdeck Restaurant.

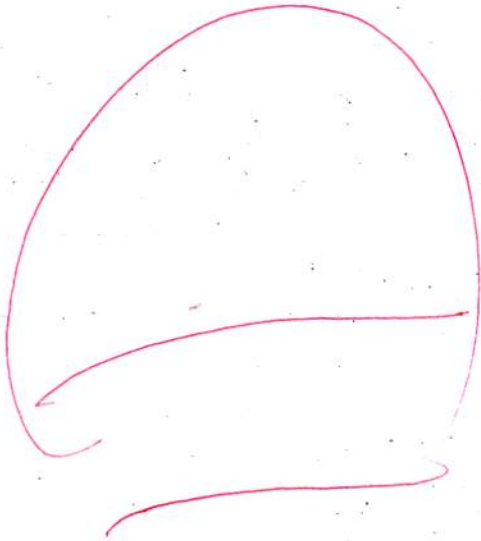

Would you use public transportation (bus service) between Naples and Portland if it was offered in the Town of Naples.

(Note. There is a service being planned that would run from Bridgton to Portland and back. There would be a trips to Portland early in the morning and mid morning, then trips from Portland mid afternoon and early evening. It is expected that the rates would be approximately \$3-\$4 per one way trip with reduced rates for seniors, children, and the needy. The cost of the service would be supported by rider fares, federal grants, and property tax dollars of which Naples share would be approximately \$2,931.)
